



My NEVER AGAIN List

1. **NEVER AGAIN** will I confess or believe that “I can’t” because the Word of God says, “I can do all things through Jesus Christ who strengthens me.” (Philippians 4:13)
2. **NEVER AGAIN** will I confess or live in fear, because the Word of God says, “God has not given me a spirit of fear, but of power, love and of a sound mind.” (2 Timothy 1:7)
3. **NEVER AGAIN** will I confess or live in doubt or lack of faith, because the Word of God says, “God has dealt to each one [that means me too] a measure of faith.” (Romans 12:3)
4. **NEVER AGAIN** will I confess or believe I’m weak, because the Word of God says, “The Lord is the strength of my life” (Psalm 27:1) and “The people that know their God shall be strong and carry out great exploits.” (Daniel 11:32)
5. **NEVER AGAIN** will I confess or believe satan has supremacy over my life, because the Word of God says, “Greater is He that is within me than he that is in the world.” (1John 4:4)
6. **NEVER AGAIN** will I confess or live in defeat, because the Word of God says, “God always causes me to triumph in Jesus Christ.” (2 Corinthians 2:14)
7. **NEVER AGAIN** will I confess or lack wisdom, because the Word of God says, “Christ Jesus has become for me wisdom from God.” (1 Corinthians 1:30) and “If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him.” (James 1:5)
8. **NEVER AGAIN** will I confess or focus on sickness, because the Word of God says, “With His stripes I am healed.” (Isaiah 53:5) and “[Jesus] Himself took my infirmities and bore my sickness.” (Matthew 8:17)
9. **NEVER AGAIN** will I confess or focus on bondage, because the Word of God says, “Where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.” (2 Corinthians 3:17) and “My body is the temple of the Holy Spirit.” (1 Corinthians 6:19)
10. **NEVER AGAIN** will I confess or worry, because the Word of God says, I am “Casting all of my cares upon Him who cares for me.” (1 Peter 5:7)
11. **NEVER AGAIN** will I confess or live in condemnation, because the Word of God says, “There is NOW no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus.” (Romans 8:1). I am in Christ; therefore I am free from condemnation!

12. **NEVER AGAIN** will I confess or live in loneliness, because the Word of tells me Jesus said, “I am with you always, even till the end of the age.” (Matthew 28:20) and “I will never leave you, nor forsake you.” (Hebrews 13:5)
13. **NEVER AGAIN** will I confess or live under curses or bad luck, because the Word of God says, “Christ has redeemed me from the curse of the Law, being made a curse for me: that the blessings of Abraham might come upon the gentiles [that’s me] through Jesus Christ: that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.” (Galatians 3:13-14)
14. **NEVER AGAIN** will I confess or be discontented, because the Word of God says, “I have learned in whatever state I am, to be content.” (Philippians 4:11)
15. **NEVER AGAIN** will I confess or focus on unworthiness, because the Word of God says, “He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.” (2 Corinthians 5:21)
16. **NEVER AGAIN** will I confess or live in confusion, because the Word of God says, “God is not the author of confusion, but of peace.” (1 Corinthians 14:33) and “We have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God.” (1 Corinthians 2:12)
17. **NEVER AGAIN** will I confess or focus on persecution, because the Word of God says, “If God be for us, who can be against us?” (Romans 8:31)
18. **NEVER AGAIN** will I confess or believe that sin must still dominate my life, because the Word of God says, “The law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.” (Romans 8:2)
19. **NEVER AGAIN** will I confess or accept insecurity, because the Word of God says, “When you lie down, you will not be afraid; Yes, you will lie down and your sleep will be sweet. Do not be afraid of sudden terror, nor of trouble from the wicked when it comes; for the Lord will be your confidence and will keep your foot from being caught.” (Proverbs 3:24-26)
20. **NEVER AGAIN** will I confess that I’m a failure, because the Word of God says, “In all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us.” (Romans 8:37)
21. **NEVER AGAIN** will I confess or lived frustrated because the Word of God says, “You will keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on You, because he trusts in You.” (Isaiah 26:3)

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
